versatile display

I display my **bone china** on different-sized **custom-made crates** (acmecase.com), which can be made into shelving and moved around.



irresistible invites



To ensure my **invitations** for gift fairs don't go unnoticed, or get lost in a pile, I send ones that pop up. I use **Paper & Pixel** (paperandpixel.com.au), which focuses on 3D paper engineering.

it's a wrap

We wrap our bone china in thick, recycled **packaging paper**, from Kennards Self Storage (kss.com.au). It's strong and protects the delicate details in some of our pieces. And to transport our delicate items, we use **Star Track Couriers** (startrackexpress.com.au) – I recommend them for any fragile freight.

sensational shopping

The Philippines' **Manila** is a shopping mecca! You'll find huge floors of beautiful homewares in large stores **Shoemart** and **Rustan's**.

travel inspiration
